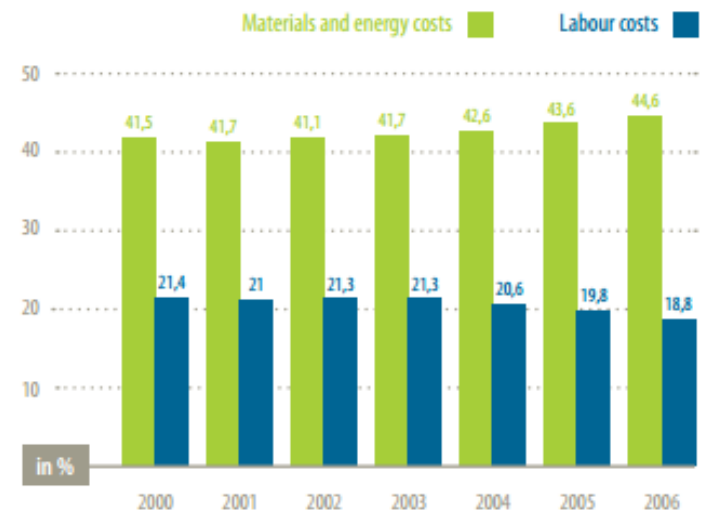
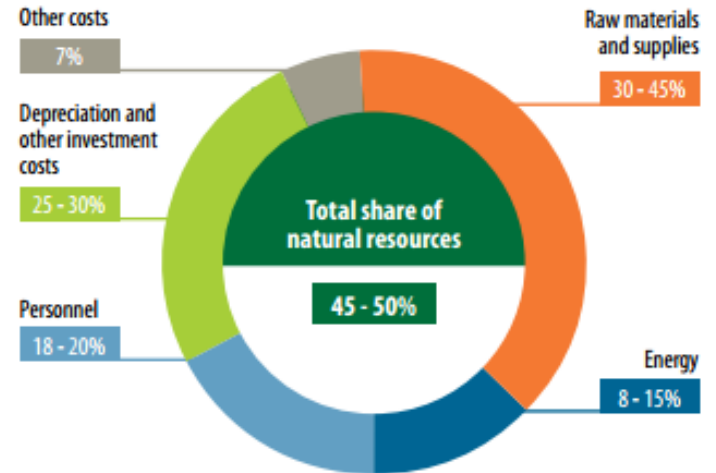
- 65 billion t/a raw materials enter the economic system;
- Around 60% of waste ends up in landfill...
- Rising prices for materials and energy;
- Supplies of precious materials are running low;
- Environmental damage from resource extraction, landfilling and waste disposal.

IS THE WORLD AN UNLIMITED RESOURCE AND WASTE BIN ?





- Natural resources make up 45-50% of costs for the average manufacturing company;
- Labour costs are falling as a percentage of total costs, whilst materials and energy costs rise;
- Small Business Act (2010) estimates that better resource use could save European industry €630billion.



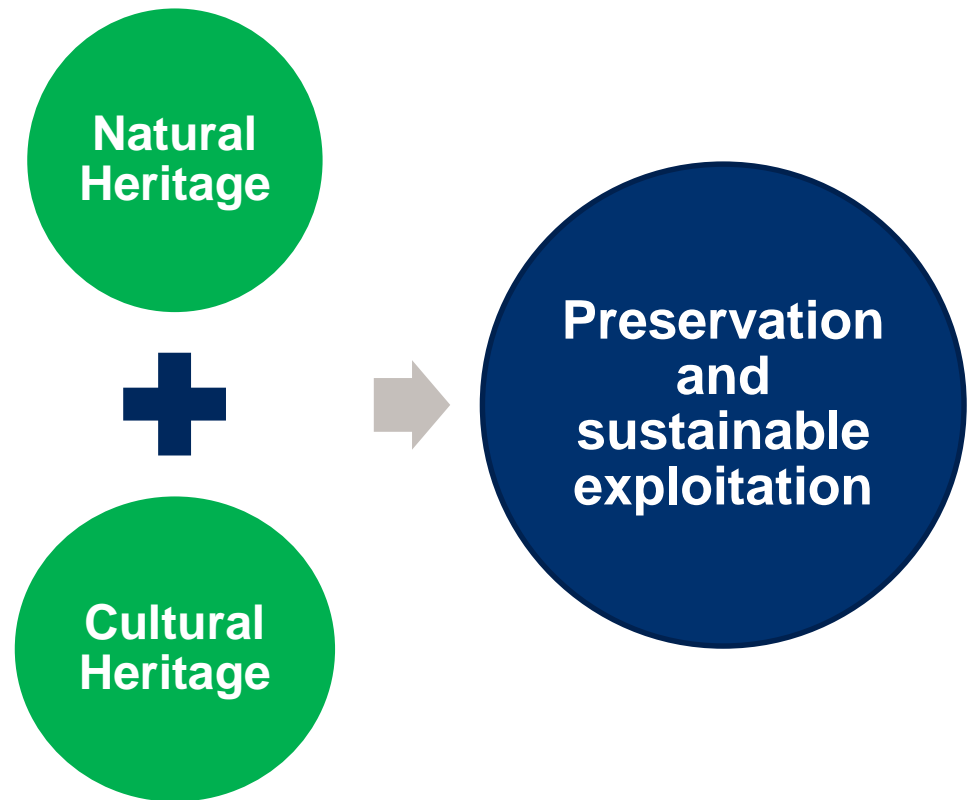
INTERREG EUROPE:

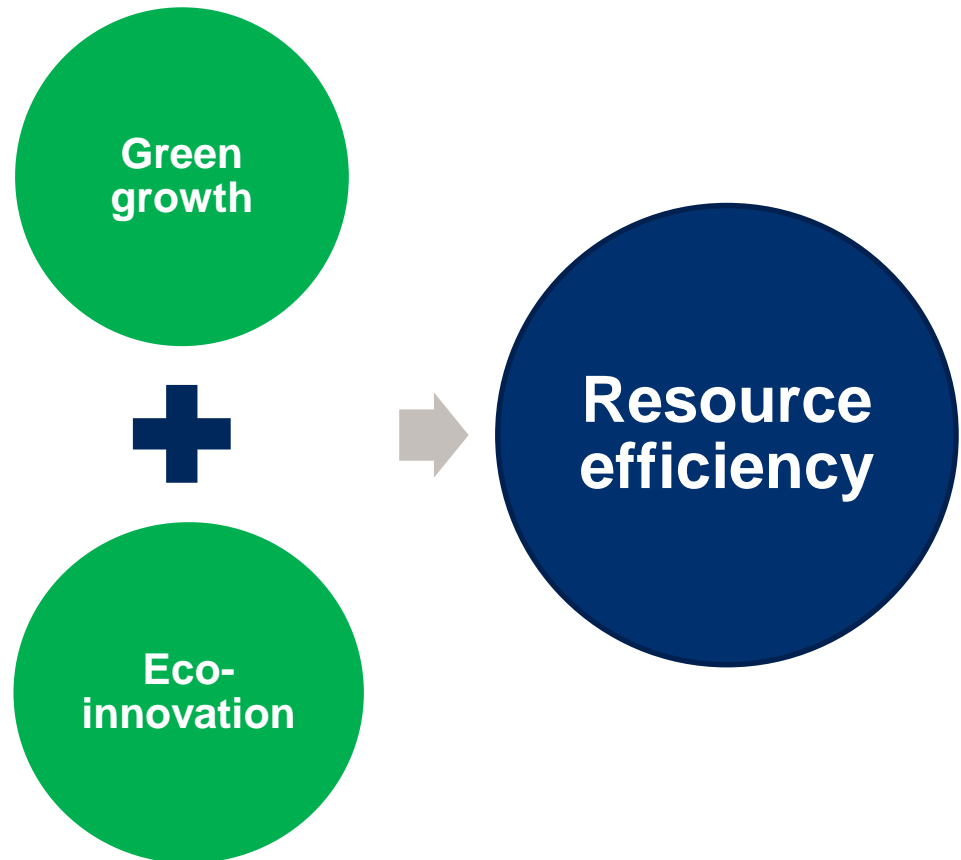
